

# **#1176-C WHITE PINES**

Turn your home into a winter wonderland with these festive and sparkly trees. With a variety of sizes, you can crochet a forest that adds a magical touch to any room. The combination of Valley Yarns Northampton and Sesia Bluebell make them look like a fresh snowfall.

#### Skill Level: Beginner

Sizes: XS (S, M, L)

#### Finished Measurements:

Height: 3½ (8¼, 11, 15½)" Base Circumference: 7¾ (10½, 14, 16¼)"

### Yarn Requirements:

To make 1 tree of each size: 2 balls Valley Yarns Northampton (100% Wool, 100g/247yds). Color: White. 3 balls Sesia Bluebell (42% Mohair/ 40% Polyester/ 18% Silk, 25g/136yds). Color: 051-Pearly White.

Hook: US size H/8 (5.0 mm), or size needed to get gauge.

**Other Materials:** 1 locking stitch marker, tapestry needle, styrofoam cones to fit finished trees or polyfill if you prefer to stuff them.

**Gauge:** 17 sts and 17 rnds = 4" in single crochet in back loops with one strand of each yarn held together.

### Notes:

Each tree is worked in the round from the top down with spaced increases to create the cone shape. One strand of each yarn is held together for all sizes. Place the locking stitch marker in the first sc of the round to mark the beginning of round. As you come to that stitch on subsequent rounds, sc into the marked stitch, then remove the marker and place it in the stitch just made.

### Size XS Only:

Ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. **Note:** For remaining stitches, work into back loop only unless otherwise specified. Rnd 1: Sc around. 6 scs. **Rnd 2:** \*Sc 1, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 9 scs. Rnd 3: \*Sc 2, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 12 scs. Rnd 4: Sc around. Rnd 5: \*Sc 3, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 15 scs. Rnd 6: \*Sc 4, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 18 scs. Rnd 7: Sc around. Rnd 8: \*Sc 5, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 21 scs. **Rnd 9:** \*Sc 6, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 24 scs. Rnd 10: Sc around. Rnd 11: \*Sc 7, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 27 scs. Rnd 12: \*Sc 8, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 30 scs. Rnd 13: Sc around. Rnd 14: \*Sc 9, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 33 scs.



Sl 1 In both loops to join. Fasten off.

## Sizes S and M Only:

Ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. **Note:** For remaining stitches, work in back loop only unless otherwise specified. Rnd 1: Sc around. 6 scs. Rnd 2: \*Sc 1, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 9 scs. Rnds 3 and 4: Sc around twice. Rnd 5: \*Sc 2, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 12 scs. Rnd 6: Sc around. Rnd 7: \*Sc 3, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 15 scs. Rnds 8 and 9: Sc around twice. Rnd 10: \*Sc 4, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 18 scs. Rnd 11: Sc around. Rnd 12: \*Sc 5, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 21 scs. Rnds 13 and 14: Sc around twice. Rnd 15: \*Sc 6, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 24 scs. Rnd 16: Sc around. Rnd 17: \*Sc 7, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 27 scs. Rnds 18 and 19: Sc around twice. Rnd 20: \*Sc 8, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 30 scs. Rnd 21: Sc around. Rnd 22: \*Sc 9, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 33 scs. Rnds 23 and 24: Sc around twice. Rnd 25: \*Sc 10, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 36 scs. Rnd 26: Sc around. Rnd 27: \*Sc 11, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 39 scs. Rnds 28 and 29: Sc around twice. Rnd 30: \*Sc 12, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 42 scs. Rnd 31: Sc around. Rnd 32: \*Sc 13, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 45 scs. Rnds 33 and 34: Sc around twice. Size Small Only: SI 1 In both loops to join.

Fasten off.

Size Medium Only: Rnd 35: \*Sc 14, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 48 scs. Rnd 36: Sc around. Rnd 37: \*Sc 15, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 51 scs. Rnds 38 and 39: Sc around twice.



Rnd 40: \*Sc 16, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 54 scs.
Rnd 41: Sc around.
Rnd 42: \*Sc 17, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 57 scs.
Rnds 43 and 44: Sc around twice.
Rnd 45: \*Sc 18, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 60 scs.
Rnd 46: Sc around.
Sl 1 In both loops to join.
Fasten off.

Size L Only: Ch 2, sc 6 in second ch from hook. Note: For remaining stitches, work in back loops only unless otherwise specified. Rnds 1 and 2: Sc around twice. 6 scs. Rnd 3: \*Sc 1, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 9 scs. Rnds 4 and 5: Sc around twice. Rnd 6: \*Sc 2, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 12 scs. Rnds 7 and 8: Sc around twice. Rnd 9: \*Sc 3, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 15 scs. Rnds 10 and 11: Sc around twice. Rnd 12: \*Sc 4, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 18 scs. Rnds 13 and 14: Sc around twice. Rnd 15: \*Sc 5, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 21 scs. Rnds 16 and 17: Sc around twice. Rnd 18: \*Sc 6, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 24 scs. Rnds 19 and 20: Sc around twice. Rnd 21: \*Sc 7, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 27 scs. Rnds 22 and 23: Sc around twice. Rnd 24: \*Sc 8, inc 1: rep from \* to end of rnd. 30 scs. Rnds 25 and 26: Sc around twice. **Rnd 27:** \*Sc 9, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 33 scs. Rnds 28 and 29: Sc around twice. Rnd 30: \*Sc 10, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 36 scs. Rnds 31 and 32: Sc around twice. **Rnd 33:** \*Sc 11, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 39 scs. Rnds 34 and 35: Sc around twice. Rnd 36: \*Sc 12, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 42 scs. Rnds 37 and 38: Sc around twice. Rnd 39: \*Sc 13, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 45 scs. Rnds 40 and 41: Sc around twice. Rnd 42: \*Sc 14, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 48 scs. Rnds 43 and 44: Sc around twice. Rnd 45: \*Sc 15, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 51 scs. Rnds 46 and 47: Sc around twice.



Rnd 48: \*Sc 16, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 54 scs.
Rnds 49 and 50: Sc around twice.
Rnd 51: \*Sc 17, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 57 scs.
Rnds 52 and 53: Sc around twice.
Rnd 54: \*Sc 18, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 60 scs.
Rnds 55 and 56: Sc around twice.
Rnd 57: \*Sc 19, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 63 scs.
Rnds 58 and 59: Sc around twice.
Rnd 60: \*Sc 20, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 66 scs.
Rnds 61 and 62: Sc around twice.
Rnd 63: \*Sc 21, inc 1; rep from \* to end of rnd. 69 scs.
Rnds 64 and 65: Sc around twice.
Sl 1 In both loops to join.
Fasten off.

### Finishing - All Sizes:

Weave in ends on WS of work. Place over styrofoam cone or stuff with polyfill. Pin in place, if desired.

#### Abbreviations:

**Ch:** chain; **Inc:** increase (2 single crochets in one stitch); **Rnd:** round; **Rep:** repeat; **Sc**: single crochet; **Sl**: slip stitch; **St(s)**: stitch(es)
