Autumn Wreath Chair Décor



EASY

SIZE

Finished Size

8 in (20.3 cm) diameter

MATERIALS

- BOYE® Ribbon and Crewel Needles, 6 pc
- Floral foam wreath, 8-inch (20.3 cm) diameter
- Wool felt, olive
- Wool felt, chartreuse
- Super bulky yarn - oatmeal
- #4 medium weight yarn - linen, robin's egg, and gingerbread
- Embroidery floss to match felt colors
- Craft glue

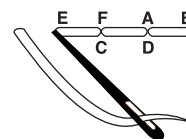
NOTE

One skein of super bulky yarn should make approximately 2-3 wreaths, depending on how tightly you wrap it.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Back stitch

Come up at A, down at B, up at C, down at D (same hole as A), etc. Always go back into the same hole as the previous stitch so your stitches look connected.

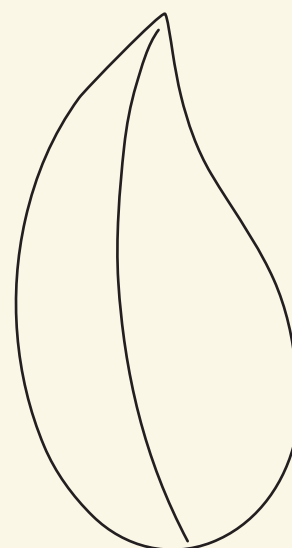


INSTRUCTIONS

1. Using the super bulky oatmeal yarn, begin wrapping it around the foam wreath. Work the first few wraps over the starting end to secure it.
2. Continue wrapping until the entire wreath is covered. Secure the yarn end under the wrapped yarn.
3. Use the leaf pattern to cut two leaves from both the olive and chartreuse felt.
4. Use coordinating embroidery floss and a Boye needle to back stitch a line down the center of each leaf as shown by the line on the leaf pattern.
5. Tightly roll small yarn balls in assorted sizes ranging from 1/2 in (1.2 cm) to 1-1/4 in (3.1 cm) in diameter, using the #4 yarns.
6. Glue the leaves to the bottom of the wreath allowing a little space in the middle for the yarn balls.

7. Glue the yarn balls to the wreath between the leaves.
8. Cut two lengths of the super bulky yarn, making them twice the desired length for a hanger.
9. Fold the yarn pieces in half. Working from the underside of the wreath top bring the center fold through to the wreath front. Bring the loose ends through the loop to create a hanger.
10. Attach hanger to chair so wreath hangs at desired height and trim any excess yarn.
