Crochet Mug Cozy

Crochet Mug Cozy



SIZE

Finished Circumference About 12.5 in (31.7 cm) including straps Finished Height About 3.5 in (8.9 cm)

GAUGE

Gauge is not critical for this project.

MATERIALS

- BOYE® Crochet Hook, US size H (5mm)
- BOYE® Plastic Yarn Needle
- #4 medium weight yarn soft olive and robin's egg

NOTE

1. Pattern fits a large mug that is 3.5 in (8.9 cm) diameter, 4.375 in (11.1 cm) tall, and 11.625 in (29.5 cm) circumference, excluding handle.

STITCH EXPLANATION

BPdc (back post double crochet)

Yarn over and insert hook around the post (instead of through a stitch), working from back to front and out the back again. Complete the double crochet as normal.

FPdc (front post double crochet)

Yarn over and insert hook around the post (instead of through a stitch), working from front to back and out the front again. Complete the double crochet as normal.

BODY OF COZY (soft olive):

Ch 40.

Row 1: Ch 2 (counts as first dc). Starting in 4th ch from hook, dc in each st of chain. Ch 2 and turn.

Row 2: Ch 2 from row 1 counts as first st in this row. BPdc in first 3 st. *[FPdc in next 4 st, BPdc in next 4 st]. Repeat * across the row. Remember to include the turning chain from row 1 (created when you skipped 3 ch). Ch 2 and turn.

Row 3: FPdc in the first 3 st, *[BPdc in the next 4 st, FPdc in the next 4 st.] Repeat * across the row. Ch 2 and turn.

Repeat sequence of rows 3-2-2-3-3. Faster

Repeat sequence of rows 3-2-2-3-3. Fasten off. Weave in ends and trim excess.

STRAPS AND BORDER (robin's egg):

- **1.** Starting at opposite end of row from where you fastened off, sc across long edge to opposite corner.
- 2. Begin strap ch 17.
- **3.** Starting in 2nd ch from hook make loose sl st in each ch. Sl st to base of ch 17 into the side of the last sc.

- **4.** Sc into same st as last sc. Sc across short edge (about 14 st). Sc in last st of row (corner), remove hook from working loop.
- **5.** Insert hook through end of strap and then pick up the working loop, making sure strap is not twisted. DO NOT yarn over, pull working loop through the strap and pull snug.
- **6.** Sc in corner st. Continue sc across long edge to corner.
- **7.** Repeat steps 2-5 for second strap. SI st into starting sc of border to close. Fasten off, Weave in ends and trim excess.
