# Knit Mug Mat



EASY

## SIZE

### Finished Size

5 in x 5 in (12.7 cm x 12.7 cm) without fringe  
7.5 in x 7.5 in (19 cm x 19 cm) with fringe

## GAUGE

Gauge is not critical for this project.

## MATERIALS

- BOYE® Straight Knitting Needles, size 9 (5.25 mm) 10-inch (25.4 cm) length
- BOYE® Plastic Yarn Needle
- BOYE® Latch Hook Tool
- #4 medium weight yarn - robin's egg

## NOTES

1. Pattern can be adjusted up or down by changing the number of cast on stitches and number of rows.
2. The latch hook tool makes it easy to add fringe to any knit project.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

### Long tail cast on

The long tail cast on is sturdier and less prone to stretch out as you knit compared to a simple loop cast on.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- CO 20 stitches with a long tail cast on.
- **Row 1:** Turn the work around, bring the yarn to the back, and K every stitch.
- **Row 2:** Turn the work around, bring the yarn to the back again, and K every stitch.
- Repeat until you have a total of 38 rows.
- BO and weave in the yarn ends.
- Cut (80) 3-inch (7.6 cm) lengths of yarn.
- Use the latch hook tool to add fringe to all outer edges, including the corners.
- Trim fringe to 1.25 inches (3.1 cm).

## ABBREVIATIONS

CO = cast on

K = knit

BO = bind off
