



*Yarn Tassel
Napkin Ring*

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EASY

SIZE

Finished Size

2 in wide x 5 in high (5 cm x 12.7 cm)

MATERIALS

- BOYE® Cabone Ring, 2 in (5 cm)
- BOYE® Yarn Needles, size 13
- #4 medium weight yarn - soft olive
- Decorative wooden bead - 5/8 in (16 mm) diameter with 1/8 in (3 mm) opening

NOTE

You will need 1 cabone ring and 1 wooden bead for each napkin ring.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Cut two 10-inch (25.4 cm) pieces of yarn.
2. Fold the pieces in half over the cabone ring.
3. Thread the ends of the yarn through the bead and tie a single knot.
4. Cut (24) 8-inch (20.3 cm) pieces of yarn.
5. Lay the pieces across the yarn ends hanging below the bead and move two of the yarn ends on top of the pieces.
6. Take the yarn ends on the top and the yarn ends on the bottom and tie them together in a tight double knot around the 8-inch (20.3 cm) pieces. Fold the ends of the 8-inch (20.3 cm) pieces downward to create the tassel bundle.
7. Cut a 10-inch (25.4 cm) piece of yarn. Starting about 1/2-inch (12 mm) below the bead, wrap the yarn several times around the bundle, and secure by running the end of the yarn through the wraps. Trim any excess.
8. Trim the bottom of the bundle to make a 3-inch (7.6 cm) tassel. Use the yarn needle to fluff/separate the yarn ends if desired.
