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CELEBRATION WREATH

MATERIALS

YARN: 300 Yarns Category 5 Bulky Yarn

Asylum Fibers used for samples

OTHER MATERIALS:

wreath frame or round cut cardboard
rolls 7/8th" wide ribbon in colors of choice
roll each color
Scissors
Large needle for tidying up pom pom ends
Glue gun (optional but recommended)
Large Clover Pom Pom maker
Medium Clover Pom Pom maker

TIP: Wait until all pom poms are placed before cutting any ends or gluing them.

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ELEMENTS:

Make 3 Large Pom Poms Make 15 medium Pom Poms

ASSEMBLY:

Affix the 3 large Pom Poms at the bottom of the wreath frame by tying them on. Make sure that are toward the bottom of the frame.

Take 12 medium pom poms and tie them around the frome to fill out the frame.

Take the 3 remaining medium pom poms and place them over the 3 large pom poms, pushing them super close together.

When you are happy with the placement of the pom poms, cut the ties and glue them to the frame to secure them

After the glue is dried from the pom poms, Starting at the outside of one of the big pom poms, take your ribbon and wrap it around the entire frame and pom poms starting with color A and stop when you get to the outside of the other big pom pom.

Repeat the above step with color B ribbon.

Glue those ribbons into place.

Now take Color A & B ribbon and cut long pieces and wrap them around the outside medium and big pom poms of your center bottom section and glue them in place.

Once the whole piece is dry, you can hang for seasonal decor.

You can also make a full ring of medium pom poms and add a single accent bow at the bottom like shown here.



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
