Havana Bandana

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SIZE

Triangle measures 8.5 inches tall x 18 inches wide and ties measure 14 inches each.

GAUGE

4 shells = 4 inches

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- Scrap worsted yarn in 5 colors or <u>Yarn</u>
 <u>Citizen Harmony Worsted</u> (worsted weight, 50% wool/50%alpaca yarn; 3.5oz/211 yds/100g per hank): 1 hank each in Aloe, Apricot, Blossom, Lavender, and Mist.
- US Size H (5mm) crochet hook
- Tapestry needle

NOTES

- 1. Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.
- Cut yarn after each color change, or let color not in use follow loosely up along the side until used again.
- Chain-1 at beginning of row does not count as a stitch unless otherwise stated.
- Chain-4 at beginning of row counts as first treble crochet unless otherwise stated.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Beginning shell (beg shell): (1 tr, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated sp. **Double Crochet Shell (dc-shell):** (2 dc, ch 2, 2 dc) in indicated sp. **Treble Crochet Shell (tr-shell):** (dc, tr, ch 2, tr, dc) in indicated sp.

Ending shell (end shell): (2 dc, ch 2, 1 tr) in indicated sp. **Picot-Shell:** (2 tr, ch 3, sl st in first ch, 2 tr) in indicated sp.

TRIANGLE

Row 1 (RS): With color A ch 4 (counts as dc + 1 ch), working into 4th ch from hook; dc, (ch 2, 2 dc) 3 times in same ch, turn. (8 dc, 3 ch-2 sps)

Row 2: Ch 4 (see Pattern Notes), sk next dc, beg shell (see Special Stitches) in first ch-2 sp, sk 2 dc, dc-shell (see Special Stitches) in next ch-2 sp, sk 2 dc, end shell (see Special Stitches) in last ch-2 sp, tr in top of beg ch-4, turn. Change to color B (see Pattern Notes). (1 beg shell, 1 dc-shell, 1 end shell, 2 tr)

Row 3: With color B ch 4, tr in same st as beg ch, ch 2, (dc-shell in next ch-2 sp) 3 times, ch 2, 2 tr in top of beg ch-4, turn. Change to color C. (3 dc-shell, 2 ch-2 sps, 4 tr)

Row 4: With color C ch 4, beg shell in first ch-2 sp, (dc-shell in next ch-2 sp, dc-shell in sp before next dc-shell) twice, dc-shell in next ch-2 sp, ending shell in last ch-2 sp, tr in top of beg ch-4, turn. Change to color D. (1 beg shell, 5 dc-shell, 1 end shell, 2 tr)
Row 5: With color D ch 4, tr in same st as beg ch, ch 2, (dc-shell in next ch-2 sp) 3 times, ch 2, tr-shell (center tip - see Special Stitches), ch 2, (dc-shell in next ch-2 sp)

3 times, ch 2, 2 tr in top of beg ch-4, turn. Change to color E. (1 tr-shell, 6 dc-shell, 4 ch-2 sps, 4 tr)

Row 6: With color E ch 4, beg shell in first ch-2 sp, dc-shell in each ch-2 sps to sp before tr-shell in center tip, dc-shell in sp before center tr-shell, dc-shell in ch-2 sp of tr-shell, dc-shell in sp after center tr-shell, dc-shell in each ch-2 sps to last ch-2 sp, end shell in last ch-2 sp, tr in top of beg ch-4, turn. Change to color A. (1 beg shell, 9 dc-shell, 1 end shell, 2 tr)

Row 7: With color A ch 4, tr in same st as beg ch, ch 2, dc-shell in each ch-2 sp to dc-shell in center tip, ch 2, tr-shell in ch-2 sp of center dc-shell, ch 2, dc-shell in each ch-2 sp to end of row, ch 2, 2 tr in top of beg ch-4, turn. Change to color B. (1 tr-shell, 10 dc-shell, 4 ch-2 sps, 4 tr)

Rows 8-12: Continue working as Rows 6 and 7 alternately changing colors in the same order, ending with a row 6. (1 beg shell, 21 dc-shell, 1 end shell, 2 tr)

Row 13 (RS): With color B ch 4, tr in same st as beg ch, picot-shell in each ch-2 sp to end of row, 2 tr in top of beg ch-4. Fasten off. (23 picot-shell, 4 tr) **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = begin(ning)(s)

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

rnd(s) = rounds

RS = right ride

sc = single crochet

sp = space

st(s) = stitches

tr = treble-crochet

TIES & EDGE

Row 1 (RS): With optional color ch 50, working across long side (ends of rows) of triangle with RS facing, work 3 sc around post of each tr/ch-4 across (also work around color strands carried along the side), ch 51, turn.

Row 2: Starting in 2nd ch from hook, work sc in back bump of each ch across to triangle, sc in each sc across triangle, sc in back bump of each rem chs, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc across. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
