



Turkey Hat

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EASY

SIZE

Finished Circumference

About 20 in. (51 cm), Hat will stretch to fit a range of sizes

GAUGE

13 sts + 24 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm) over St st worked in rnds (k every st of every rnd) with yarn A.

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® HOMESPUN® (Art. #790) #408 Wildfire 1 skein (A)
- LION BRAND® VANNA'S CHOICE® (Art. #860) #098 Fisherman 1 ball (B)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® stitch holders
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

- Circular knitting needle size 10 (6 mm), 16 in. (40 cm) long
- Double pointed knitting needles size 10 (6 mm), set of 5

NOTES

1. Hat is worked in three pieces: Hat and 2 Drumstick Earflaps
2. Hat is worked in rnds from the top downwards, with Bobbles placed randomly

STITCH EXPLANATION

MB (Make Bobble)

1. On RS, knit into front of next st do not drop st from left needle, knit into back of same st do not drop st from left needle, then knit once more into front of same st and drop st from left hand needle – 3 sts for bobble on right hand needle.

Working on the 3 sts for bobble:

2. On WS, turn and knit the 3 sts.
3. On RS, turn and purl the 3 sts.
4. Pass 3rd and then 2nd st over first st and off right hand needle.

M1 (make 1) An increase worked by lifting the horizontal strand lying between needles and placing it onto the left needle. Knit this new stitch through the back loop – 1 st increased.

ssk (slip, slip, knit) Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together – 1 st decreased.

HAT

With double pointed needles and A, cast on 8 sts. Divide sts onto 4 needles, placing 2 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left needle with the working yarn from the right needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Knit 7 rnds.

Next rnd (Increase rnd): (K1, M1, place marker) 7 times, k1, M1 – you will have 16 sts in this rnd and will have placed 7 more markers for a total of 8 markers (including the beg of rnd marker). Each marker indicates where increases will be made.

Knit 1 rnd.

Next rnd (Increase rnd): (Knit to next marker, M1, slip marker (sm)) 7 times, k to end of rnd, M1 – 24 sts. Rep last 2 rnds until you have 64 sts (16 sts on each of 4 needles).

Change to circular needle as you work the next rnd.

Note: Don't forget to move your end of round marker when you change to the circular needle!

Work in St st worked in rnds (k every st of every rnd) for 5 rnds.

Next rnd (Bobble rnd): Knit AND work 3-4 Bobbles (MB) randomly spaced around. Rep last 6 rnds until piece measures about 8 1/2 in. (21.5 cm) from first Increase rnd.

Lower Ribbing

Next Rnd Rib Pattern: * K1 through back loop, p1; rep from * to end of rnd. Rep last rnd 3 more times. Bind off in rib pattern.

EARFLAPS (make 2)

With double pointed needles and A, cast on 6 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles, placing 2 sts on each needle. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left needle with the working yarn from the right needle and being careful not to twist sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Next rnd: (K1, M1) 6 times – 12 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Next rnd: (K2, M1) 6 times – 18 sts.

Knit 1 rnd.

Next rnd: (K3, M1) 6 times – 24 sts.

Knit 7 rnds.

KNIT



Next rnd: (K4, k2tog) 4 times – 20 sts.
Knit 3 rnds.

Next rnd: (K3, k2tog) 4 times – 16 sts.
Knit 3 rnds.

Next rnd: (K2, k2tog) 4 times – 12 sts.
Knit 3 rnds.
Cut A.

Change to 3 strands of B held together.
Knit 3 rnds.

Next rnd: K3, place next 6 sts on a holder,
k2, M1, k1 – 7 sts.

Next rnd: K1, M1, k6 – 8 sts.
Knit 3 rnds.

Next rnd: (Ssk, k2tog) twice – 4 sts.
Cut yarn, leaving long yarn tails. Thread
tails through remaining sts and pull to close
opening at end of Earflap.
Knot securely.

Next rnd: With 2 strands of B held together
and working over 6 sts on holder, (k2, M1)
twice, k2 – 8 sts.
Knit 3 rnds.

Next rnd: (Ssk, k2tog) twice – 4 sts.
Cut yarn, leaving long yarn tails. Thread
tails through remaining sts and pull to close
opening.
Knot securely.

FINISHING

Sew Earflaps to sides of Hat.

Weave in yarn ends.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

k = knit

p = purl

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = rounds

RS = right side

st(s) = stitches

St st = Stockinette stitch

WS = wrong side
