# Lion Brand® Local Grown Cable Knit Pillow



EASY

## SIZE

About 14 x 14 in. (35.5 x 35.5 cm)

## GAUGE

18 sts = about 4 in. (10 cm) over Cable pattern in Rows 1-4.  
BE SURE TO CHECK GAUGE.

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® LOCAL GROWN (Art. #668)  
#146 Quail 2 balls
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle
- Knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm)
- Circular knitting needles size 9 (5.5 mm), 40 in. (100 cm) long (for edging)
- Fiberfill stuffing or 14 x 14 in. (35.5 x 35.5 cm) pillow form

## MATERIALS NOTE

If preferred, use the circular needle to work the Back and Front, working back and forth in rows just as if working with straight needles.

## NOTES

1. Pillow is made in 2 identical pieces: Front and Back.
2. Both pieces are worked back and forth in rows of a Cable pattern.
3. An edging is worked all the way around each piece, then pieces are sewn together and stuffed to form Pillow.

## STITCH EXPLANATION

**2/2 LC (2 over 2 left cross)** Slip 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front, k2, then k2 from cable needle.

**LT (Left Twist)** Knit 2nd st on left needle through the back loop and leave on left needle. Then knit both the first and 2nd sts together through the back loop and slip both sts off needle.

## FRONT

With straight needles, cast on 64 sts.

**Set-Up Row (WS):** K1, \* p2, k2, p4, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

## Cable Pattern

**Row 1 (RS):** K1, LT, \* p2, k4, p2, LT; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 2:** K1, \* p2, k2, p4, k2; rep from \* to last 3 sts, p2, k1.

**Row 3:** K1, LT, \* p2, 2/2 LC, p2, LT; rep from \* to last st, k1.

**Row 4:** Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-4 until piece measures about 14 in. (35.5 cm) from beg, end with a Row 4 as the last row you work.

Bind off.

## Edging

From RS with circular needle, pick up and k64 sts evenly spaced along each of the 4 sides of piece. Place marker for beg of rnd. Join by working the first st on left hand needle with the working yarn from the right hand needle – you will have 256 sts.

Purl 1 rnd.

Bind off as if to knit.

## BACK

Make same as Front, including Edging.

## FINISHING

Hold Front and Back with WS together. From RS, sew Front to Back along 3 sides, sewing just inside the edging. Stuff Pillow, then sew last side of Pillow closed.

Weave in ends.
