# Lion Brand® Local Grown Fingerless Gloves



## SIZE

**Finished Circumference** About 8 in. (20.5 cm)  
**Finished Length** About 11 in. (28 cm)

## GAUGE

12 sts + 10 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over  
(sc, dc) pattern of Row 2.  
BE SURE TO CHECK GAUGE.

## MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® LOCAL GROWN (Art. #668)  
#122 Hickory 1 ball
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle
- Crochet hook size J-10 (6 mm)

## NOTES

1. Each Glove is made from a rectangle, worked back and forth in rows.
2. Side edges of rectangles are sewn together, leaving an opening for thumb, to form Fingerless Gloves.

## FINGERLESS GLOVES (make 2)

Ch 25.

**Row 1:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \* dc in next ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last ch, dc in last ch – you will have 24 sts in this row.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, turn, sc in first dc, \* dc in next sc, sc in next dc; rep from \* to last st, dc in last sc.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 11 in. (28 cm) from beginning.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail for sewing.

## FINISHING

Fold one rectangle in half, bringing long edges together. With yarn tail still attached to piece, sew long edges together for about 7 in. (18 cm), leave the next 1 1/2 in. (4 cm) unsewn for thumb opening, then sew remainder of long edges together.  
Rep for second Glove.

Weave in ends.

## CROCHET
