MATERIALS

HOOK: US E / 3.5mm crochet hook

YARN:

Fingering weight yarn in Green ~50 yards (Uncommon Threads Everyday Sock)

Fingering weight yarn in Blue ~20 yards (Uncommon Threads Cloud Fingering)

Fingering weight yarn in White ~20 yards (Uncommon Threads Everyday Sock)

OTHER MATERIALS:

Safety eyes 6mm (or black embroidery floss) Yarn scraps or polyfiber fill for stuffing Red embroidery floss for mouth White embroidery floss for stars on cloak Scissors Large needle for sewing up Stitch marker

ABBREVIATIONS

BLO: back loops only BOR: beginning of round ch: chain Dec: decrease FLO: front loops only FO: finish off Inc: increase MR: magic ring method for starting crocheting in the round PM: place marker Rnd: round sc: single crochet slst: slip stitch st(s): stitch(es) WE: work even

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PATTERN

Body (starting from the top of the head) in green Working in the round without turning Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6 sts) Rnd 2: Inc around (12 sts) Rnd 3: *sc, inc* repeat around (18 sts) Rnd 4: *inc, sc 2* repeat around (24 sts) Rnd 5: *sc 3, inc* repeat around (30 sts) Rnd 6: *inc, sc 4* repeat around (36 sts) Rnd 7 - 10: WE (36 sts) Rnd 11: *sc 4, dec* repeat around (30 sts) Rnd 12: *sc 3, dec* repeat around (24 sts) Stuff the head well

Rnd 14: *sc 1, dec* repeat around (12 sts)

Rnd 15: WE (12 sts)

Rnd 16: Inc around (24 sts)

Rnd 17 & 18: WE (24 sts)

Rnd 19: Sc in 1st 6 sts, skip 6 sts (this will become the first arm later), sc in next 6 sts and leave last 6 sts of rnd unworked (this will become the second arm later). Slst to first st of rnd. (12 sts)

Rnd 20 & 21: WE (12 sts)

Stuff body well, do not cut yarn

Legs & Feet in green

For the first leg, you will be continuing from where yarn is attached on the body:

Rnd 1: Sc in next 6 sts, slst to first st of rnd, leaving remaining 6 sts of rnd unworked (6 sts)

Rnd 2 - 8: WE (6 sts)

Gently stuff the first leg.

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Rnd 9: Ch 1, pinch the work in half and sc through both thicknesses of sts across (3 sts worked in a row)

You will now be working in rows to make the foot:

Row 2: Inc across (6 sts) Row 3: WE (6 sts) FO

For the second leg, reattach your yarn to any of the remaining unworked 6 sts on the body of the frog. Work as for the first leg and foot.

Weave in ends and sew up any gaps at the base of the legs

Arms & Hands in green

Reattach your yarn to one of the sets of 6 sts that are unworked from Rnd 19 of the body.

Rnd 1: Sc across, slst to first st of rnd to work in the rnd (6 sts)

Rnd 2 - 6: WE (6 sts)

You will now be working in rows to make the hand:

Row 2: Inc across (6 sts)

Row 3: WE (6 sts)

FO

Repeat all rounds and rows for the second arm.

Eye Bumps in green (make two)

Working in the round without turning

Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6 sts)

Rnd 2 & 3: WE (6 sts)

FO, snap safety eyes into the eye bumps. Use scissors or flush cutters to remove the post at the back of the safety eyes once they are snapped securely.

Finishing up the Frog

Weave in any ends securely and attach eye bumps to top of head. Embroider a cute smile on the face.

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Magic Cloak in blue

Working in rows and starting at the neckline Row 1: Ch 11, turn and sc across (10 sts) Row 2: Inc across (20 sts) Row 3: Inc in 1st st, sc to last st, inc in last st (22 sts) Row 4: WE (22 sts) Row 5: Inc in 1st st, sc to last st, inc in last st (24 sts) Row 6: WE (24 sts) FO and make the ties: Reattach yarn to 1st chain of Row 1, ch 10, FO Reattach yarn to last ch of Row 1, ch 10, FO Weave in all ends, embroider small x shapes on the back with white embroidery floss.

Wizard Hat in white

Working in the round without turning Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6 sts) Rnd 2: Inc, sc in remaining sts (7 sts) Rnd 3 & 4: WE (7 sts) Rnd 5: In FLO, inc around (14 sts) Rnd 6: WE (14 sts) FO, weave in ends

Bag of Magic in white

Working in the round without turning Rnd 1: 6 sc in MR (6 sts) Rnd 2: *Inc, sc* around (9 sts) Rnd 3: WE (9 sts) Ch 15, skip 4 sts, slst in next st FO, weave in ends
