#### **MEASUREMENTS**

Approx 11" x 64" [28 x 162.5 cm].

## **GAUGE**

16 sc and 17 rows = 4" [10 cm]. **Be sure to check your gauge.** 

#### **MATERIALS**

- Bernat<sup>®</sup> Cotton Terry<sup>®</sup> (4.2 oz/120 g; 229 yds/209 m)
- Contrast A Celery (48008)
  1 ball or 165 yds/150 m
- Contrast B Wetlands (48014)
  1 ball or 165 yds/150 m
- Size U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates\*
  Silvalume\* crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge.
- Susan Bates® stitch markers.
- Susan Bates\* yarn needle.
- · Sewing needle.
- Coats Dual Duty XP\* all-purpose thread in matching color.

VINE #1 Worked with A. See diagram on page 4. Leaf-1: With A, ch 28.

\*\*1st row: SI st in 9th ch from hook - First petal made, (Ch 10, SI st in 9th ch from hook) 4 times - Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth petals made. Ch 6. SI st in 5th ch from hook - Sixth petal made. Ch 5. Sl st in 4th ch from hook - Seventh petal made. Ch 4. SI st in 3rd ch from hook -Eighth (top) petal made. **Do not** turn. Work in rem loops of foundation ch of previous petals, sl st in next ch (between Eighth and Seventh petals). Ch 4. Sl st in 4th ch from hook -petal made. SI st in next ch (between Seventh and Sixth petals). Ch 5, Sl st in 5th ch from hook - petal made. SI st in next ch (between Sixth and Fofth petals). [Ch 9. SI st in 9th ch from hook - petal made. SI st in next ch (between next 2 petals)] 4 times. Ch 9. SI st in 9th ch from hook - last petal made. SI st in each of next 3 ch (after last petal) of foundation chain.\*\*




DIAGRAM FOR PETALS

Leaf-2 to Leaf-11: Rep Leaf 1.

#### Leaf-12 and Leaf-13:

See diagram on page 4. Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.



**Leaf-14 to Leaf-24:** Working in rem loops of foundation ch between leaves, 1 sc in each of next 16 ch. Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.

**Leaf-25 and Leaf-26:** As Leaf-12. See diagram on page 4. Join with sl st to first ch of foundation chain. Fasten off.

**VINE #2** Worked with B. See diagram on page 4.

First Leaf: With B, ch 20. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1 of Vine #1.

## **Second to Eleventh Leaves:**

Ch 28. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1 of Vine #1.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

Approx = Approximately

Ch(s) = Chain(s)

Rem = Remain(ing)

Sc = Single crochet

SI st = Slip stitch

**Leaf-12:** Ch 20. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.

**Leaf-13 and Leaf-14:** Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.

**Leaf-15:** Working in rem loops of foundation ch between leaves, 1 sc in each of next 8 ch. Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.

**Leaf-16 to Leaf-25:** Working in rem loops of foundation ch between leaves, 1 sc in each of next 16 ch. Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.

**Leaf-26:** Working in rem loops of foundation ch between leaves, 1 sc in each of next 8 ch. Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1.

## Leaf-27 and Leaf-28:

Ch 12. Work from \*\* to \*\* as given for Leaf-1. Join with sI st to first ch of foundation chain. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Place Vine #1 and Vine #2 on long flat surface parallel to each other.



Following arrows on Assembly Diagram, starting from *left* to *right*, carefully bring Leaf-25 of Vine #2 over ch-16 "stem" of Vine #1 and align with Leaves 23 and 24 of Vine #1. Bring Leaf-1 of Vine #1 over ch-16 "stem" of Vine #2 and align with Leaves 1 and 2 of Vine #2.



Repeat for all leaves from both Vines, alternating leaves.



**Note:** Distribute leaves at each end of Vines evenly, alternating where possible.




With sewing needle and matching sewing thread sew ch-9 loops between each other to secure them in position.


