



Knit For You
Stocking

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EASY

MEASUREMENTS

Approx 8" [20.5 cm] wide x 18" [45.5 cm] long, excluding hanging loop.

GAUGE

9 sts and 14 rows = 4" [10 cm] in stocking st with Bernat Blanket. **Be sure to check your gauge.**

MATERIALS

- **Bernat® Blanket®** (10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)
- **Main Color (MC)** Light Teal (10734) 1 ball or 112 yds/102 m **or** Gold (10970) **or** Terracotta Rose (10880)
- **Bernat® Softee Chunky®** (3.5 oz/100 g; 108 yds/99 m)
- **Contrast A** Natural (28008) 1 ball or 50 yds/45.5 m
- Set of 4 size U.S. 10½ (6.5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® double-pointed knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® stitch marker.
- Susan Bates® stitch holder. Susan Bates® yarn needle.

NOTES

1. Stocking is worked from top edge down in one piece in the rounds on set of 4 double-pointed needles.
2. Heel and Toe shapings are worked using wrapped stitches and short-turn rows.
3. When working wrapped sts, pick up wrap and place into onto left-hand needle and knit or purl next st together tightly with wrapped st to avoid holes in your work.
4. Monogram Letter is Duplicate Stitched with Contrast A after Stocking is complete.

STOCKING

With MC, cast on 36 sts. Divide sts onto 3 needles (12, 12, 12). Join in rnd, placing marker on first st.

1st rnd: Knit.

2nd rnd: Purl.

3rd and 4th rnds: Rep 1st and 2nd rnds.

Cont even in stocking st (knit all rnds) until Stocking measures 11" [28 cm].

Shape Heel (worked back and forth in rows): ****1st row:** K18. **Turn.** Leave rem 18 sts on a st holder.

2nd row: P17. W&T.

3rd row: K16. W&T.

4th row: P15. W&T.

5th row: K14. W&T.

4th row: P13. W&T.

5th row: K12. W&T.

Cont to work each row 1 stitch **less**, as established, until 6 unwrapped sts rem.

Next row: P7, purling wrap with last st.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Begin(ning)

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit next 2 stitches together

P = Purl

Rem = Remain(ing)

Rep = Repeat

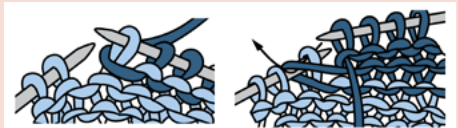
Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

W&T = With yarn at back of work, slip next stitch purlwise onto right-hand needle. Bring yarn to front of work between needles. Slip stitch back onto left-hand needle unworked and bring yarn to back of work – stitch is now 'wrapped'. Turn. **Note:** To avoid a hole when knitting a slipped st, pick up the st below the slipped st and slip it onto left hand needle. Knit this st tog with slipped st above.



WS = Wrong side

Turn.

Next row: K8, knitting wrap with last st.

Turn.

Next row: P9, purling wrap with last st.

Turn.

Next row: K10, knitting wrap with last st.

Turn.

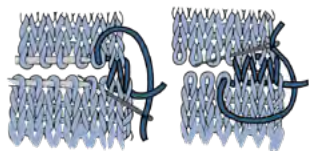
Cont to incorporate 1 stitch **more** each row, as established, until all 18 sts have been worked.**

Shape Foot (return to working in rnd):

1st rnd: K18 across sts on st holder. K18 across Heel sts. 36 sts. Place marker on last st.

Knit even in rnds until Foot from marked rnd after Heel shaping measures 5" [12.5 cm].

Shape Toe: Work from ** to ** as for Shape Heel. Break yarn leaving a long end. Graft sts from last row of Toe to last rnd of Foot.

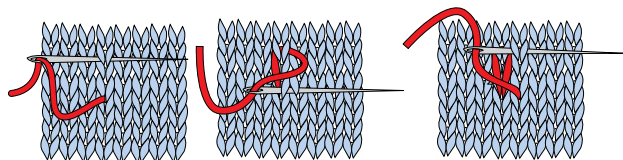


GRAFTING

FINISHING

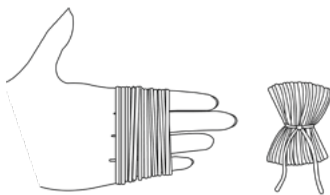
Choose letter of choice from Chart (shown on page 4) and embroider letter using A and Duplicate Stitch onto Front of stocking approx 3½" [9 cm] below top edge and 2" [5 cm] in from side edge.

Note: Insert piece of cardboard inside Stocking when working Duplicate Stitch embroidery to avoid stitching through all thicknesses. To ensure full coverage of background, **do not** pull too tightly when working duplicate stitch.



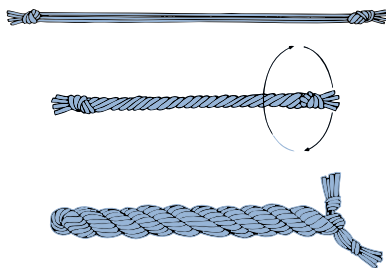
DUPLICATE STITCH

Pompom: Wind A around 4 fingers approx 100 times. Remove from fingers and tie tightly in center. Cut through each side of loops. Trim to a smooth round shape, 4" [10 cm] diameter.



Twisted Cord: Cut 3 lengths of MC 72" [183 cm] long. Hold all strands tog and with someone holding other end, twist strands to the right until cord begins to curl. Fold the 2 ends tog and tie in a knot so it will not unravel. The strands will now twist themselves tog.

Attach Pompom to folded end of Twisted Cord. Attach opposite end of Twisted Cord to top edge of Stocking, creating a hanging loop approx 3" [7.5 cm] high as shown in photo.



Fasten off.

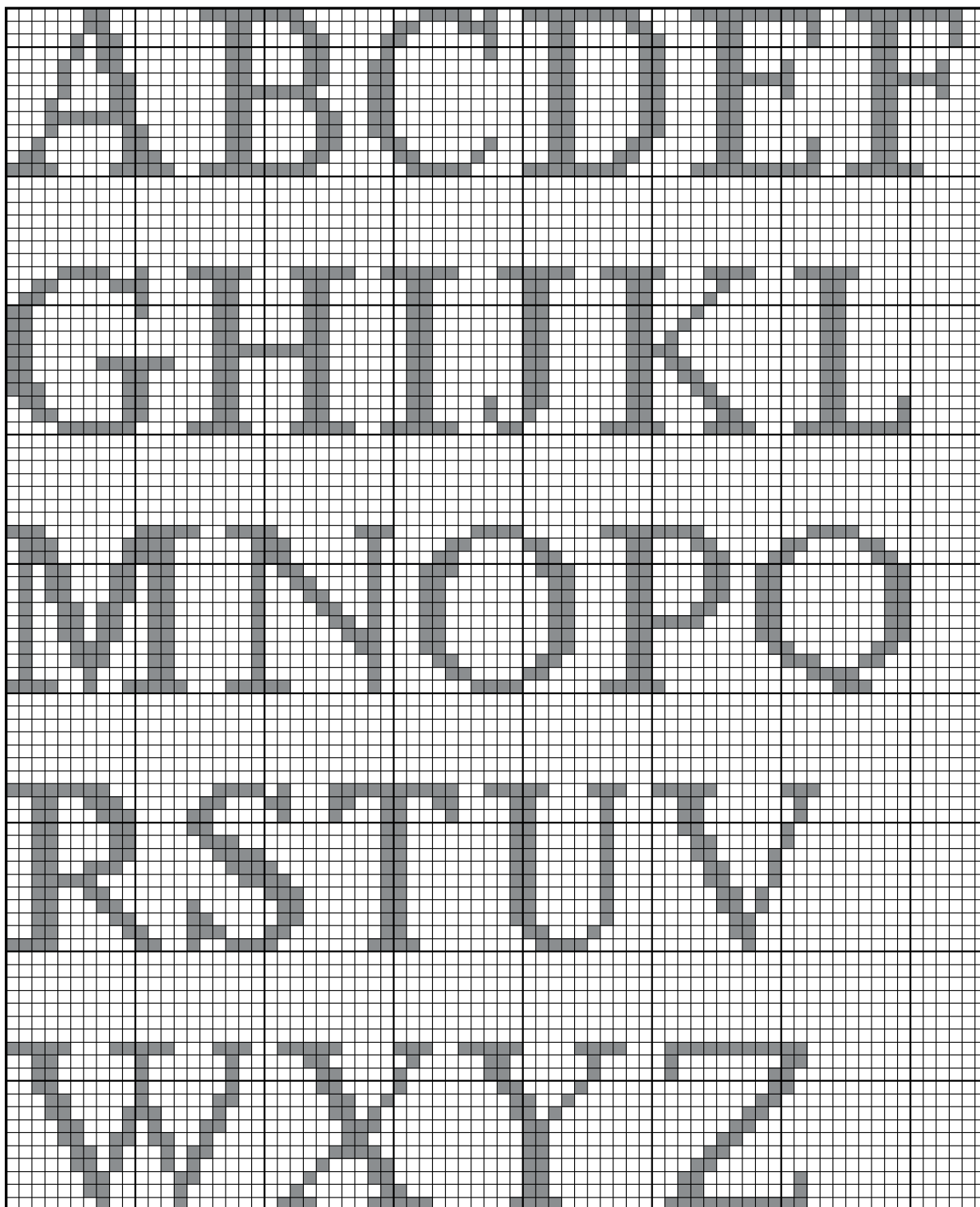
FINISHING

Following Pom-Pom Maker package directions, make a large pom-pom. Tie pom-pom to top of Hat. Weave in ends.



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
