Pumpkin Pie Hat



INTERMEDIATE

SIZE

Finished Circumference

16, 17, 18, 19, 20" circumference
(unstretched) x 7, 7.5, 8.5, 9, 10" tall

GAUGE

16 sts x 24 rows = 4" (10 cm) in stockinette
stitch, using larger needles

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- Cascade Yarns® 128 Superwash® -
100% Superwash Merino Wool;
100 g (3.5 oz) / 128 yds (117 m)
 - #822 Pumpkin - 1 skein (MC)
 - #520 Vanilla 1 - skein (CC)
- US 8 (5 mm) 16-20" circular
knitting needles
- US 10 (6 mm) 16-20" circular
knitting needles
- US 10 (6 mm) 16-20" double pointed
knitting needles (DPNs)
- Stitch markers
- Yarn needle

NOTES

1. Pom-pom is made separately and
tied to top of Hat.

BEGIN PATTERN

With smaller circular needles and CC,
CO 60 (64, 68, 72, 76)sts.
Join to work in the round, being careful not
to twist stitches. Place marker at start of
rnd.

K1, P1 for 1" (1", 1.5", 1.5", 2") from cast on
edge.

K 1 round.

Change to MC and larger needles.

K1, KFB around 90 (96, 102, 108, 114)sts

K for 2.5", 3", 3.5", 4", 4.5"

K 15 (16, 17, 18, 19) sts, pm (will add 5
markers)

CROWN

(change to dpns as necessary)

Decrease round: K until 2 sts before
marker, K2tog, sm.

Repeat decrease round until 6 sts are left.

FINISHING

Cut yarn, leaving a tail for sewing and with
yarn needle run through remaining sts.
Cinch to close the top of the hat and
secure.

Weave in all ends.

If desired make a pom pom out of CC and
attach to top.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = Cast on

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together

KFB = Knit front and back

P = Purl

PM = Place stitch marker

SM = Slip stitch marker

St(s) = Stitch(es)
