Tweedy Wrap

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INTERMEDIATE

SIZE

Finished Measurements:

11.5" wide x 60" long (not including fringe)

GAUGE

16 sts x 28 rows = 4" (10 cm) in Tweedy Pattern using larger needles

MATERIALS

- Cascade Yarns® Pacific® Chunky 60% Acrylic / 40% Superwash Merino Wool; 100 g (3.5 oz) / 120 yds (110 m)
 - #153 Ganache - 2 skeins (A)
 - #158 Copper Brown - 1 skein (B)
 - #113 Bordeaux - 1 skein (C)
 - #69 Navy - 1 skein (D)
 - #166 Toasted Coconut - 1 skein (E)
- US 8 (5 mm) 40-60" circular knitting needles
- US 10 (6.5 mm) 40-60" circular knitting needles

NOTES

1. When working with a new color, leave an 8-10" tail before starting a new row. At the end of each row, cut yarn leaving an 8-10" tail. The tails will be used later for fringe.

SET-UP EDGE

Rows 1-3: K2, *[P1, K1] - rep from * to last 3 sts, end P1, K2
Change to larger needles
K 1 row

TWEEDY PATTERN

Row 1: With B - K2, *[Slwyib1, K1] - rep from * until last 3 sts, Sl1wyib, K2
Row 2: With C - K3, *[Sl1wyif, K1] - rep from * until last 2 sts, K2
Row 3: With D - K2, *[Slwyib1, K1] - rep from * until last 3 sts, Sl1wyib, K2
Row 4: With E - K3, *[Sl1wyif, K1] - rep from * until last 2 sts, K2
Row 5: With A - K2, *[Slwyib1, K1] - rep from * until last 3 sts, Sl1wyib, K2
Row 6: With B - K3, *[Sl1wyif, K1] - rep from * until last 2 sts, K2
Row 7: With C - K2, *[Slwyib1, K1] - rep from * until last 3 sts, Sl1wyib, K2
Row 8: With D - K3, *[Sl1wyif, K1] - rep from * until last 2 sts, K2
Row 9: With E - K2, *[Slwyib1, K1] - rep

from * until last 3 sts, Sl1wyib, K2
Row 10: With A - K3, *[Sl1wyif, K1] - rep from * until last 2 sts, K2
Do Rows 1-10 of the Tweedy Pattern a total of 7 times.
Switch to smaller needles.
Ending Edge:
Rows 1-3: With A - K2, *[P1, K1] - rep from * to last 3 sts, end P1, K2

FINISHING

Tie ends in groups of 3-4 strands to create fringe. Trim fringe to 6" from edge. Steam block lightly if desired.

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = Cast on

K = Knit

P = Purl

rep = Repeat

Slwyib1 = Slip one stitch with yarn

held in back

Slwyif = Slip one stitch with yarn

held in front

St(s) = Stitch(es)
