Pumpkin Napkin Holder & Place Card

Finished Size: Approx. 3.5" wide x 2.5" tall (excluding stem and tag)

Materials:

- 2" wooden rings (Amazon)
- Yarn in orange, brown, and deep green
- Clover Pom Pom Maker (#45 size)
- Large-eye yarn needle
- Thin twine or strong thread
- Brown cardstock (for name tags)
- Scissors, pen or marker

Instructions

- 1. Wrap the Wooden Ring
- Wrap deep green yarn tightly around the entire wooden ring. Ensure full coverage.

 Tie and tuck in the ends.

Clover

2. Make the Pom Pom

- Using orange yarn and the Clover #45 pom pom maker, create a dense pom pom. Before tying it off, insert 3 long strands of brown yarn through the center.

3. Form the Stem

- Tie off the pom pom with the 3 brown strands. Braid the 6 tails (3 pairs) to form a stem. Knot and trim.

4. Attach Pumpkin to Ring

- Thread twine through the center of the pom pom using a large needle. Tie securely around the wrapped ring.

5. Add the Name Tag

- Cut a small tag from brown cardstock and write the guest's name. Tie it to the stem using strong thread.

Finishing

Slide a cloth napkin through the wooden ring. Position the name tag to face outward on the plate.
