Materials:

- Yarn in rust, mustard, cream, forest green, and brown
- Large Tassel maker (Clover recommended)
- Wooden dowel or stick (18–24" wide)
- Twine or string for hanging
- Scissors
- Mini clothespins
- Cardstock or construction paper for leaves (or precut leaves)
- Pens or markers
- Hole punch (optional)





Instructions

- 1. Make the Tassels
 - Use your tassel maker to create tassels in your chosen colors. Vary lengths slightly for a natural look.
- 2. Attach Tassels to Dowel
 - Tie the tassels onto the dowel in a staggered or symmetrical pattern.
- 3. Prepare the Leaves
 - Cut or use precut paper leaves. Use a hole punch if desired.
- 4. Add Gratitude Notes
- Invite family or guests to write what they're thankful for on the leaves and clip them to the tassels with mini clothespins.
- 5. Hang and Display
 - Use twine to hang your wall piece. Adjust for balance and spacing.
