



Autumn Path Mosaic Washcloth

This cozy hand towel is the perfect autumnal gift for the giving season! The abstract patterning of fallen leaves gives it a woodsy feel, while the mosaic chart is simple enough to be easily memorizable! Work it as-is for a hand towel, or double the length for a fold-over sink towel. As an added bonus, the pattern is so simple that you may want to work a whole set, swap the contrast color for a burnt orange, light brown, or forest green for the full range of leaf shades!

Finished Measurements

Finished Length: 12"

Finished Width: 7.5"

Materials and Tools

- Sample uses Peaches and Creme Original (Worsted, 100% Cotton): **MC** Dark Taupe, **CC** Gold
- Size 7 (4.5 mm) straight needles (9") or size to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle

Gauge

In pattern:

Approx 20 stitches by 40 rows = 4"

Towel Pattern

In MC, CO 37 sts.

Rows 1-38: Work all sts, referring to the colorwork chart for mosaic patterning.

Rows 39-110: Repeat rows 3-38 of colorwork chart.

Rows 111-116: Repeat rows 3-8 of colorwork chart.

Rows 117,118: Repeat rows 1,2 of colorwork chart.

Bind off, weave in all ends.
