Materials and Tools

- Sample uses Mainstays Chunky Chenille (Super Bulky, 100% Polyester):
MC Black, CC Ivory
- Size 19 (15.00 mm) straight needles (9")
or size to obtain gauge
- Yarn needle
- 17" Square Pillow Insert

Gauge

In pattern:

Approx 4 stitches by 6 rows = 4"

Pillow Pattern

Front

In MC, CO 17 sts.

Row 1: P all sts, referring to the colorwork chart for intarsia patterning.

Row 2: K all sts, referring to the colorwork chart for intarsia patterning.

Rows 3-26: Repeat rows 1,2.

Bind off, weave in all ends.

Back

In MC, CO 17 sts.

Row 1: P all sts.

Row 2: P all sts.

Rows 3-26: Repeat rows 1, 2.

Bind off, weave in all ends.
