Penguin Tracks Flat & Cowl Set



INTERMEDIATE

SIZE

Cowl: One size
12 x 8.5", measured flat

Hat: S (M, L)
18-19 (20-21, 22-23)"

GAUGE

With smaller hook, 32 sc x 28 rows = 4"

Take time to check gauge.

MATERIALS

- Yarn Citizen Harmony DK (DK weight; 50% alpaca/ 50% wool, 230 yds/100g per skein): 3 skeins, shown in Natural
- US Size D/3 (3.25mm) and US Size G/7 (4.5mm) crochet hook, or sizes needed to obtain gauge.
- 3" Pom pom maker
- Tapestry needle

NOTES

1. Hat is worked from brim and up, with (optional) pom-pom added to finish.
2. Ch-1 at beginning of a round or row does not count as a stitch.
3. Ch-2 at beginning of a round or row does count as a stitch.
4. Cowl is worked with the bottom hem first in turned rows, the body of the cowl is worked next in rounds, with the top hem worked last in rows.

STITCH EXPLANATION

Invisible Decrease (Invdec): Insert hook into the front loop of the next stitch, then insert hook through both loops of the following stitch, yo and draw up loop (drawing loop through both stitches that you inserted the hook through), yo and draw through 2 loops – 1 st decreased.

Cluster v-stitch (V-st): Working in indicated st or space, *[yo, insert hook, yo and draw up a loop] 4 times (9 loops on hook)**; ch 1, rep from * to ** once more – 2 clusters, 1 ch-1 space made.

COWL

Row 1: With smaller hook, ch 11, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (10 sc)

Rows 2-135: Ch 1, working in BLO, sc in each st across, turn.

Row 136: Ch 1, working through underside of ch of Row 1, and BLO of sts of Row 135 sl st through both thicknesses across to join ends. (10 sl sts)

Begin working in joined rounds.

Rnd 137: Ch 1, rotate to work in row-ends of hem, sc in each row-end around, join. (135 sc)

Change to larger hook.

Rnd 138: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, *skip next 2 sts, v-st in next st, skip next 2 sts, hdc in next 4 sts** rep from * to ** to last 5 sts, skip next 2 sts, v-st in next st, skip last 2 sts, join. (15 v-sts, 60 hdc)

Rnds 139-154: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, *v-st in ch-1 space of next v-st, hdc in next hdc, FPdc around next 2 hdc, hdc in next hdc** rep from * to ** to last 5 sts, v-st in ch-1 space of next v-st, join.

Rnd 155: Ch 1, *sc in next 4 sts, working

across v-st, sc in first cluster, 3 sc in ch-1 space, sc in second cluster** rep from * to ** around, join. (136 sc)

Begin working in Rows for top hem.

Row 156: Ch 11, sc in second ch from the hook, sc in next 9 ch, sl st in next 2 sts of Rnd 155, turn. (10 sc)

Row 157: Ch 1, working in BLO, skip next 2 sl sts, sc in next 10 sts, turn.

Row 158: Ch 1, working in BLO, sc in next 10 sc, sl st in next 2 sts of Rnd 155, turn.

Remaining Rows: Rep Rows 157-158, on final row sl st through both thicknesses of each side of hem to join.

COWL FINISHING

Fasten off. With tapestry needle, weave in ends.

HAT

BRIM

Row 1: With smaller hook, ch 11, sc in second ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn. (10 sc)

ABBREVIATIONS

BLO: back loop only

ch(s): chain(s)

FPdc: front post double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

rep: repeat

rnd(s): round(s)

sc: single crochet

sl st(s): slip stitch(es)

st(s): stitch(es)

yo: yarn over

Rows 2-99 (108, 117): Ch 1, working in BLO, sc in each st across, turn.

Rows 100 (109, 118): Ch 1, working through underside of ch of Row 1, and BLO of sts of Row 135 sl st through both thicknesses across to join ends. (10 sl sts)
Continue to Body.

BODY

Begin working in joined rounds.

Rnd 1: Ch 1, rotate to work in row-ends of hem, sc in each row-end around, join. (99 (108, 117) sc)

Change to larger hook.

Rnd 2: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, *skip next 2 sts, v-st in next, skip next 2 sts, hdc in next 4 sts** rep from * to ** to last 5 sts, skip next 2 sts, v-st in next, skip last 2 sts, join. (11 (12, 13) v-sts, 44 (48, 52) hdc)

Rnds 3-11: Ch 2, hdc in next 3 sts, *v-st in ch-1 space of next v-st, hdc in next hdc, FPdc around next 2 hdc, hdc in next hdc** rep from * to ** to last 5 sts, v-st in ch-1 space of next v-st, join.

Rnd 12: Ch 1, *sc in next 4 sts, working across v-st sc in first cluster, 3 sc in ch-1 space, sc in second cluster** rep from * around, join. (99 (108, 117) sc)
Change to smaller hook. Continue to Crown.

CROWN SIZING - SIZE L ONLY

Rnd 1: Ch 1, *sc 37, invdec; rep from * around, join. (114 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc 17, invdec; rep from * around, join. (108 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc 16, invdec; rep from * around, join. (102 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, *sc 15, invdec; rep from * around, join. (96 sc)

Continue to Crown - All Sizes.

CROWN SIZING - SIZE M ONLY

Rnd 1: Ch 1, *sc 16, invdec; rep from * around, join. (102 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc 15, invdec; rep from * around, join. (96 sc)

Continue to Crown - All Sizes.

CROWN SIZING - SIZE S ONLY

Rnd 1: Ch 1, *sc 31, invdec; rep from * around, join. (96 sc)

Continue to Crown - All Sizes.

CROWN - ALL SIZES

Rnd 1: Ch 1, *sc 14, invdec; rep from * around, join. (90 sc)

Rnd 2: Ch 1, *sc 13, invdec; rep from * around, join. (84 sc)

Rnd 3: Ch 1, *sc 12, invdec; rep from * around, join. (78 sc)

Rnd 4: Ch 1, *sc 11, invdec; rep from * around, join. (72 sc)

Rnd 5: Ch 1, *sc 10, invdec; rep from * around, join. (66 sc)

Rnd 6: Ch 1, *sc 9, invdec; rep from * around, join. (60 sc)

Rnd 7: Ch 1, *sc 8, invdec; rep from * around, join. (54 sc)

Rnd 8: Ch 1, *sc 7, invdec; rep from * around, join. (48 sc)

Rnd 9: Ch 1, *sc 6, invdec; rep from * around, join. (42 sc)

Rnd 10: Ch 1, *sc 5, invdec; rep from * around, join. (36 sc)

Rnd 11: Ch 1, *sc 4, invdec; rep from * around, join. (30 sc)

Rnd 12: Ch 1, *sc 3, invdec; rep from * around, join. (24 sc)

Rnd 13: Ch 1, *sc 2, invdec; rep from * around, join. (18 sc)

Rnd 14: Ch 1, *sc, invdec; rep from * around, join. (12 sc)

Rnd 15: Ch 1, invdec around, join. (6 sc)
Fasten off leaving a long tail for sewing. With tapestry needle, sew remaining 6 stitches closed, weave in ends.

FINISHING

Using remaining yarn and pom-pom maker, make a 4" pom-pom and secure to top of crown. With tapestry needle, weave in ends.
