BEGINNER

SIZE

- **Finished Circumference:** About 10.5 inches (26.67 cm), will stretch to fit a range of bottles.
- **Finished Height:** 14 inches (35.56 cm), can be adjusted for any bottle size.

GAUGE

- 4 stitches per inch (2.54 cm)
 - 7 rows per inch (2.54 cm)
- Be sure to check your gauge.**

MATERIALS

- Lion Brand® Heartland® Yarn in **Badlands** and **Dry Tortugas**
- Prym® brand circular knitting needles size **8 US (5 mm)**, 32 inches (80 cm) for magic loop, or Prym® Double Point needles size **8 US (5 mm)**
- Prym® brand circular knitting needles size **5 US (3.75 mm)**, 32 inches (80 cm) for magic loop, or Prym® Double Point needles size **5 US (3.75 mm)**
- Tapestry needle
- Small Clover® Pom-Pom Maker

NOTES

1. The sleeve is worked in one piece in joined rounds from the bottom up.
2. The right side (RS) will always be facing you (outwards) as you work.
3. The bottom of your sleeve will roll on its own due to the nature of stockinette stitch.
4. Pom-poms are made separately.

Wine Bottle Sleeve Instructions:

1. **Cast-on:** 40 stitches using the cast-on method of your choice.
2. **Join in the round** and place a Beginning of Round (BOR) marker.
3. **Knit:** 7 inches (17.78 cm) or 44 rounds.
4. **Change to Rib Stitch** (K1, P1) for 7 inches (17.78 cm) or 44 rounds.
5. **Cast-off** and weave in ends.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.

Rnds 7-10: Rep Rnds 5 and 6 for 2 more times.

Rnds 11 and 12: Ch 1, working in back loops only, sc in each st around; join with sl st in first sc.
Fasten off.

FINISHING

Following the Pom-Pom Maker package directions, make a small pom-pom. Tie off the pom-pom with a 20-inch (50.8 cm) length of contrasting color yarn. Tie a knot 5 inches (12.7 cm) from the loose ends of yarn. Create a second small pom-pom, tie off with the ends of the pom-pom tassel, and trim to shape the final pom-pom.

ABBREVIATIONS

- **K** = Knit
- **P** = Purl
- **Rib Stitch** = (K1, P1)
