



Bottle Caps

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INTERMEDIATE

SIZE

Santa Hat 4.25" circumference x 3.25" height

Speckled Hat 4.25" circumference x 2.25" height

Fair Isle Hat 4.25" circumference x 3" height

GAUGE

34 sts and 48 rnds = 4" in Stockinette
Stitch in the round.

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

• Knit Picks® Stroll®

Santa Hat C1 Seashell, C2 Heartfelt

Speckled Hat C1 Seashell, C3 Wine Tasting

Fair Isle Hat C1 Seashell, C2 High Tea, C3 Cordial

• US 1 (2.25mm) DPNs

• Yarn Needle

• Stitch Markers

• 2 US size 9 or 10 straight needles or DPNs
or 2 pencils (to make mini Pom-Poms)

NOTES

Bottle caps are knit using standard hat techniques and straightforward colorwork charts, but shrunk down to fingering weight yarn and size 1 needles.

Speckled Hat

With C1, CO 36 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts; PM for BOR. Work 1x1 Rib for four rnds.

Work Speckled Chart from chart or written instructions.

Speckled Chart (in the round beginning with a multiple of 6 sts)

Rnds 1-2: K all.

Rnd 3: (With C1, K5; with C3, K1) to end.

Rnds 4-5: K all.

Rnd 6: (With C1, K2; with C3, K1; with C1, K3) to end.

Rnds 7-9: Rep Rnds 1-3.

Rnd 10: (K4, K2tog) to end. 30 sts.

Rnd 11: (With C1, K2; with C3, K1; with C1, K2) to end.

Rnd 12: (K3, K2tog) to end. 24 sts.

Rnd 13: K all.

Rnd 14: (With C3, K1; with C1, K1, K2tog) to end. 18 sts.

Rnd 15: K all.

Rnd 16: (K1, K2tog) to end. 12 sts.

Break yarn, bring though remaining sts, and pull tight.

Fair Isle Hat

With C3, CO 36 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts; PM for BOR. Work 2x2 Rib for twelve rnds.

Knit three rnds.

Work Fair Isle Chart from chart or written instructions.

Fair Isle Chart (in the rnd over an even number of sts)

Rnd 1: With C2, K all.

Rnd 2: With C3, K all.

Rnd 3: (With C1, K1; with C3, K1) to end.

Rnd 4: (With C3, K1; with C1, K1) to end.

Rnd 5: Rep Rnd 3.

Rnd 6: With C3, K all.

Rnd 7: With C2, K all

With C3, knit two rnds.

Fair Isle Crown

Rnd 1: (K4, K2tog) to end. 30 sts.

Rnd 2: K all.

Rnd 3: (K3, K2tog) to end. 24 sts.

Rnd 4: K all.

Rnd 5: (K2, K2tog) to end. 18 sts.

Rnd 6: K all.

Rnd 7: (K1, K2tog) to end. 12 sts.

Break yarn, bring though remaining sts, and pull tight.

Fold up ribbed cuff.

Santa Hat

With C1, CO 36 sts. Join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist sts; PM for BOR.

Rnd 1: K all.

Rnd 2: P all.

Rep Rnds 1-2 once more

Break C1. Join C2.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

BOR = Beginning of the Round

CO = Cast On

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit 2 together

P = Purl

rep = repeat

rnd(s) = rounds

RS = right side

st(s) = stitches

1x1 Rib - K1, P1, rep around

KNIT



With C2, knit five rnds.

Santa Crown

Rnd 1: (K10, K2tog) to end. 33 sts.

Rnds 2–3: K all.

Rnd 4: K4, (K2tog, K9) two times, K2tog, K to end. 30 sts.

Rnds 5–6: K all.

Rnd 7: (K8, K2tog) to end. 27 sts.

Rnds 8–9: K all.

Rnd 10: K3, K2tog, (K7, K2tog) two times, K to end. 24 sts.

Rnds 11–12: K all.

Rnd 13: (K4, K2tog) to end. 20 sts.

Rnds 14–15: K all.

Rnd 16: (K3, K2tog) to end. 16 sts.

Rnds 17–18: K all.

Rnd 19: (K2, K2tog) to end. 12 sts.

Rnds 20–21: K all.

Rnd 22: (K1, K2tog) to end. 8 sts.

Rnds 23–24: K all.

Rnd 25: (K2tog) to end. 4 sts.

Rnd 26: K all.

Break yarn, bring through remaining sts, and pull tight.

Finishing all Hats

Weave in ends, wash, and block if desired to measurements or as you like.

Make a Mini Pom-Pom

Use desired color and a set of straight knitting needles or DPNs (US size 9 or 10) or 2 pencils.

Step 1: Holding needles or pencils next to each other, but with a little gap in between, wrap yarn around both needles approx 25 times. Break yarn.

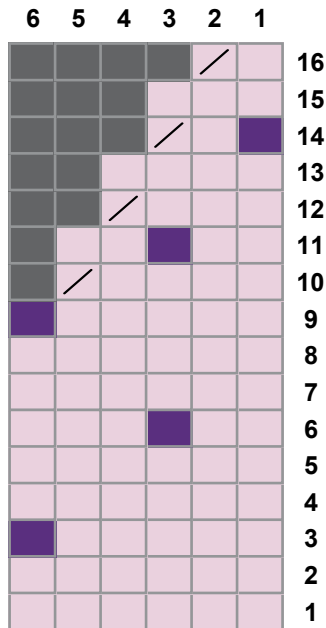
Step 2: Cut a piece of yarn in the same color approx 8" long. Pull it between needles and tie it tightly around the wrapped yarn. It's important that it is tied very tightly so that it cinches all the wrapped yarn together, to hold pom-pom together.

Step 3: Slide pom-pom off needles/pencils and cut through all the loops.

Step 4: Trim any loose ends, but be sure not to cut the longer pieces used to tie the yarn together.

Step 5: Use remaining long pieces of yarn and a yarn needle to sew the pom-pom to the tip of the hat.

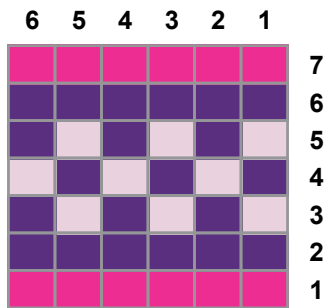
