# *Cable Knit Candle Cozies*

# Cable Knit Candle Cozies



INTERMEDIATE

## MEASUREMENTS

To fit flameless pillar candle 3" [7.5 cm] diameter:

**Small:** Approx 3¾" [9.5 cm] tall.

**Large:** Approx 5" [12.5 cm] tall.

## GAUGE

18 sts and 24 rows = 4" [10 cm] with larger needles in stocking st.

## MATERIALS

- **Red Heart® Super Saver®**  
(7 oz/197 g; 426 yds/389 m)  
Soft Navy (0387) or Carrot (0256) or Hot Red (0390)  
**Small:** 1 ball or 34 yds/31 m  
**Large:** 1 ball or 48 yds/44 m  
**Note:** 1 ball will make approx 12 Small Cozies or 8 Large Cozies.

- Sizes U.S. 7 (4.5 mm) and U.S. 8 (5 mm) Susan Bates® Silvalume® knitting needles **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® cable needle.
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.
- Flameless pillar candles 3" [7.5 cm] diameter.

## INSTRUCTIONS

### Small Cozy

With larger needles, cast on 19 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K4. P1. K9. P1. K4.

**2nd and alt rows:** K5. P9. K5.

**3rd row:** K4. P1. K3. C6F. P1. K4.

**5th row:** K4. P1. K9. P1. K4.

**7th row:** K4. P1. C6B. K3. P1. K4.

**8th row:** As 2nd row.

Rep last 8 rows for pat until work from beg measures approx 9½" [24 cm], ending on an 8th row. Cast off.

Sew cast on and cast off edges tog.

### Large Cozy

With smaller needle, cast on 46 sts.

**1st row:** (RS). K1. \*K2. P2. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

Rep last row 4 times more.

**Next row:** (WS). K1. \*K2. P3. M1. P4. K2.

Rep from \* to last st. K1. 50 sts.

Change to larger needles and proceed as follows:

**1st row:** (RS). K1. \*P2. K8. P2. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**2nd row:** K1. \*K2. P8. K2. Rep from \* to last st. K1.

**3rd row:** K1. \*P2. C4B. C4F. P2.

Rep from \* to last st. K1.

4th row: As 2nd row.

Rep last 4 rows until work from beg measures approx 4" [10 cm], ending on a 1st row.

## ABBREVIATIONS

Alt = Alternate(ing)

Approx = Approximate(ly)

Beg = Begin(ning)

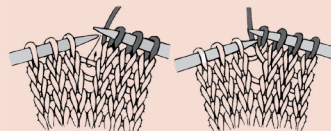
C4(6)B = Slip next 2(3) stitches onto cable needle and leave at back of work. K2(3), then K2(3) from cable needle

C4(6)F = Slip next 2(3) stitches onto cable needle and leave at front of work. K2(3), then K2(3) from cable needle

Cont = Continue(ity)

K = Knit

M1 = Make 1 stitch by picking up horizontal loop lying before next stitch and knitting into back of loop.



**Next row:** (WS). K1. \*K2. P3. P2tog. P3. K2. Rep from \* to last st. K1. 46 sts.

Change to smaller needles.

**Next 5 rows:** (RS). K1. \*K2. P2.

Rep from \* to last st. K1.

Cast off in ribbing.

Sew side seam. Weave in ends.

P = Purl

P2tog = Purl next 2 stitches together

Pat = Pattern

Rep = Repeat

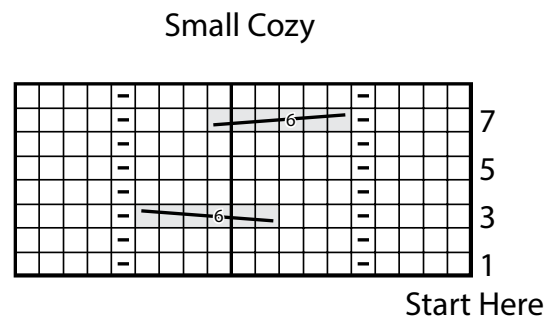
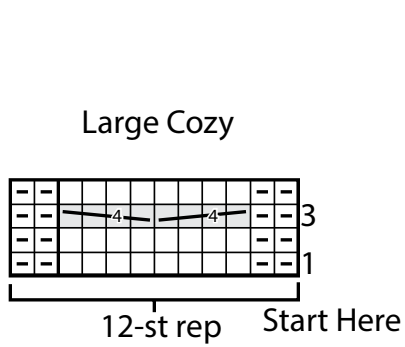
St(s) = Stitch(es)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side
