



Cherry Pi Crochet Dishcloth

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EASY

MEASUREMENT

Approx 9" [23 cm] diameter.

GAUGE

15 sc and 16 rows = 4" [10 cm].

MATERIALS

- **Lily® Sugar'n Cream® The Original™** (2.5 oz/70.9 g; 120 yds/109 m)
- **Contrast A** Jute (00082)
1 ball or 79 yds/72 m
- **Contrast B** Country Red (01530)
1 ball or 40 yds/37 m
- **Contrast C** Warm Brown (01130)
1 ball or 10 yds/9 m
- Size U.S. G/6 [4 mm] Susan Bates® Silvalume® crochet hook **or size needed to obtain gauge.**
- Susan Bates® yarn needle.

NOTES

1. Ch 3 at beg of rnd counts as dc.
2. Join all rnds with sl st to top of ch-3, unless indicated in the pattern.

INSTRUCTIONS

Base and Filling (make 1 each with A and B). See *Diagram on next page*.
Ch 4.

1st rnd: 5 dc in 4th ch from hook. Join. 6 dc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. 2 dc in each dc around. Join. 12 dc.

3rd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. 2 dc in each dc around. Join. 24 dc.

4th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. *1 dc in next dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last dc. 1 dc in last dc. Join. 36 dc.

5th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. *1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 2 dc. 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Join. 48 dc.

6th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. *1 dc in each of next 2 dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 2 dc. 1 dc in each of last 2 dc. Join. 64 dc.

7th rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. *1 dc in each of next 3 dc. 2 dc in next dc. Rep from * to last 3 dc. 1 dc in each of last 3 dc. Join. 80 dc. Fasten off.

Lattice Strips

Long Strip (make 4).

**With A, ch 2, leaving a 5" [12.5 cm] end.

1st row: 1 sc in 2nd ch from hook. Turn.

2nd row: Ch 1. 1 sc in sc. Turn.**

Rep last row until Strip measures 8" [20.5 cm], when slightly stretched.

Fasten off, leaving a 5" [12.5 cm] end.

Medium Strip (make 4).

Work from ** to ** as given for Long Strip. Rep last row until Strip measures 7" [18 cm], when slightly stretched. Fasten off, leaving a 5" [12.5 cm] end.

Short Strip (make 4).

Work from ** to ** as given for Long Strip. Rep last row until Strip measures 6" [15 cm], when slightly stretched. Fasten off, leaving a 5" [12.5 cm] end.

FINISHING

Place WS of Base and Filling pieces tog. Lay Strips on top and following Assembly Diagram on page 3, weave Strips into 'crust' top, taking care to keep Strips flat. Using yarn ends at each end of Strip, sew ends of Strips in position to outer edge (working through all thicknesses to secure all pieces).

Edging: 1st rnd: (RS). Join A with sl st through all thicknesses in any dc at outer edge. Ch 1. 1 sc in same sp as last sl st. Work 79 sc around outer edge. Join with sl st to first sc. 80 sc.

2nd rnd: Ch 3. 1 dc in same sp as last sl st. *Skip next sc. (Sl st. Ch 3. 1 dc) in next sc. Rep from * around to last sc. Skip last sc. Join with sl st at base of ch-3. Ch 13 for hanging loop. Join with sl st in last sl st. Fasten off.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx = Approximately

Beg = Beginning

Ch = Chain(s)

Dc = Double crochet

Hdc = Half double crochet

Rep = Repeat

Rnd(s) = Round(s)

RS = Right side

Sc = Single crochet

Sl st = Slip stitch

Sp(s) = Space(s)

Tog = Together

WS = Wrong side

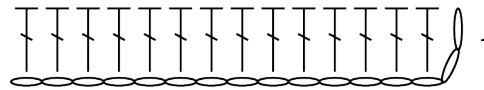


Pi Symbol

Top of Symbol

With C, ch 18.

1st row: 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each of next 12 ch. 1 hdc in next ch. 1 sc in next ch. Sl st in next ch. Fasten off.

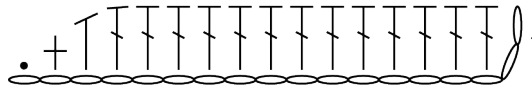


PI SYMBOL LEG

"Legs" of Symbol (make 2)

With C, ch 16.

1st row: 1 dc in 3rd ch from hook. 1 dc in each ch to end of chain. Fasten off.

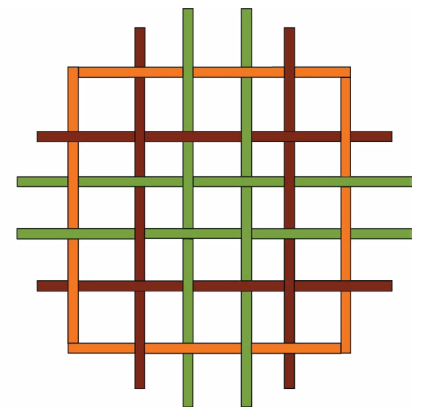
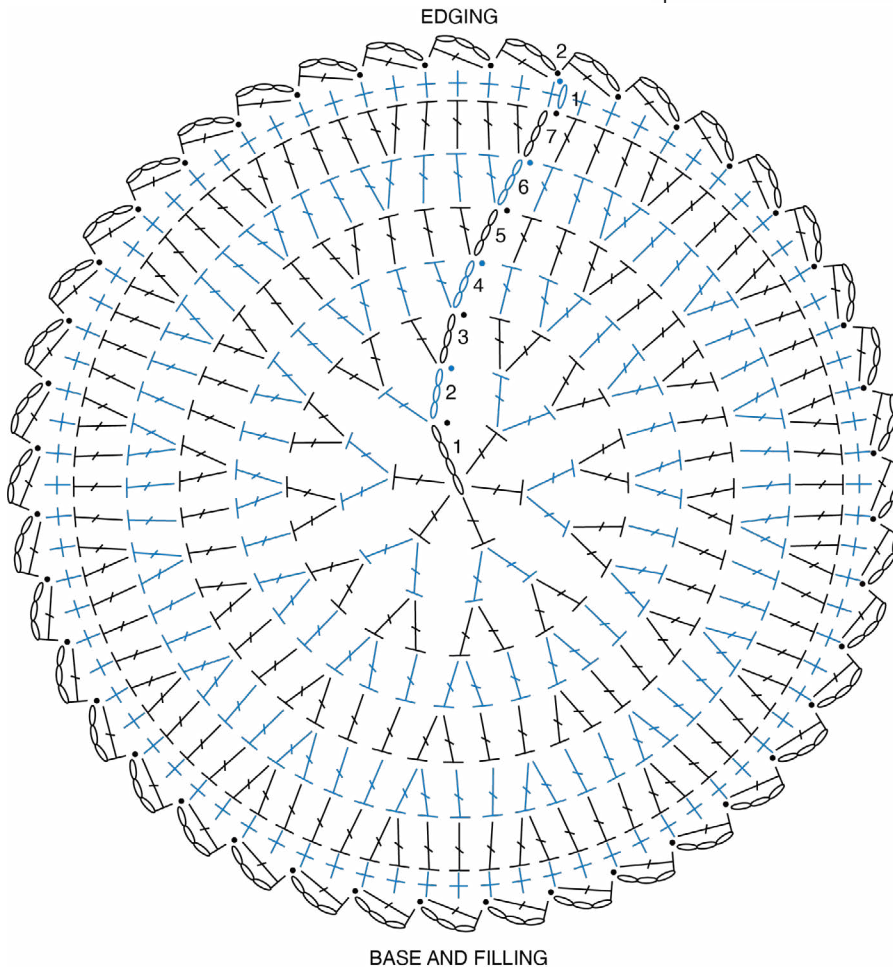


PI SYMBOL TOP

Stitch Legs of Pi Symbol to pie as shown in photo. Stitch Top of Symbol to pie, ensuring that tops of Legs are covered by Top of Symbol.

STITCH KEY

- = chain (ch)
- = slip stitch (sl st)
- + = single crochet (sc)
- ┐ = half double crochet (hdc)
- └ = double crochet (dc)
