



4-COLOR MITTENS

LION BRAND® HEARTLAND® 4-COLOR MITTENS

EASY

SIZE

Will fit most teen/adult hands

Finished Circumference About 8 in. (20.5 cm)

Finished Length About 11 1/2 in. (29 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® HEARTLAND® (Art. #136)
 - #128 Indiana Dunes 1 ball (A)
 - #135 Yosemite 1 ball (B)
 - #126 Sequoia 1 ball (C)
 - #153 Black Canyon 1 ball (D)
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)

GAUGE

16 hdc + 12 rnds = about 4 in. (10 cm).

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

hdc2tog (hdc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop) twice, yarn over and draw through all 5 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Mittens begin with a ribbed cuff worked in rows. Cuff strip is joined into a circle, and sts are worked along edge of cuff for Mitten. Mitten is then worked in joined rnds.
2. Yarn color is changed to form stripes. To change yarn color, work last st of old color to last yarn over. Yarn over with new color and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new color. Do not cut A until instructed. Carry A carefully up inside of piece.

MITTENS (make 2)

With A, ch 14.

Ribbed cuff

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – you will have 13 sts in this row.

Row 2: Ch 1, turn, working in back loops only, sc in each st across.

Rep Row 2 until piece measures about 7 in. (18 cm) from beg, end with a Row 2 as the last row you work.

Fold piece in half, bringing first row up behind last row worked, matching sts of last row and remaining loops of foundation ch.

Joining Row: Turn, working through both thicknesses, sl st in each st across to join ribbing into a circle.

Do not fasten off. Turn piece so that seam (joining) is on the inside.

Mitten

Rnd 1 (RS): Ch 1, work 28 sc evenly spaced along edge of ribbing; join with sl st in first sc – 28 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), beg in same st as joining sl st, hdc in each st around; join with sl st in first hdc.

Place a marker in the first st of this rnd and move the marker up as work progresses.

Change to B.

Rnds 3-8: Rep Rnd 2, working 1 rnd with B, 1 rnd with A, 1 rnd with C, 1 rnd with A, 1 rnd with D, and 1 rnd with A.

Cut B, C, and D; continue with A.

Shape Thumb Gusset

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in first 13 sts, 2 hdc in each of next 2 sts, hdc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in first hdc – 30 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in first 13 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 2 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in first hdc – 32 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in first 13 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 4 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in first hdc – 34 sts.

Rnd 4: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in first 13 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in next 6 sts, 2 hdc in next st, hdc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in first hdc – 36 sts.

Hand

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in first 14 sts, ch 2, place a marker on the 2nd ch, skip next 8 sts (thumb opening made), hdc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in first hdc – 28 sts and 1 ch-2.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in first 14 sts, hdc in each of next 2 ch, hdc in each st to end of rnd; join with sl st in first hdc – 30 sts. Change to B.

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in each st around; join with sl st in first hdc. Change to A.

Rnds 4-7: Rep Rnd 3, working 1 rnd with A, 1 rnd with C, 1 rnd with A, and 1 rnd with D, Change to A. Cut B, C, and D. Work remainder of mitten with A only. Rep Rnd 3 until piece measures about 9 in. (23 cm) from lower edge of cuff.

Shape Top of Mitten

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), (hdc in next 3 sts, hdc2tog) 6 times; join with sl st in first hdc – 24 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), (hdc in next 2 sts, hdc2tog) 6 times – 18 sts.

Rnd 3: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), (hdc in next st, hdc2tog) 6 times – 12 sts. Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail. Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close opening at top of Mitten. Knot securely.

Thumb

From RS, join A with sl st in marked ch at top of thumb opening, so that you are ready to work into the bottom of the ch-2.

Rnd 1: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in same ch as joining sl st, hdc in next ch, hdc in 8 skipped sts of thumb opening; join with sl st in first hdc – 10 sts.

Rnd 2: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), hdc in each st around; join with sl st in first hdc. Rep Rnd 2 until thumb measures about 2 in. (5 cm).

Next rnd: Ch 2 (does not count as a st), (hdc2tog) 5 times; join with sl st in first hdc – 5 sts.

Fasten off, leaving a long yarn tail.

Thread tail through remaining sts and pull to close opening at top of thumb. Knot securely.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
