



Rhoda Headband

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EASY

SIZE

31" long x 3.25" wide in the middle

GAUGE

24 sts and 24 rows = 4" in Stockinette
Stitch

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- Knit Picks® Aloft® (Silver 25214, 1 ball
- US 2 (2.75mm) 24" circular needles
- Yarn Needle

NOTES

Headband is worked flat in
stockinette stitch

Increases are worked on one end,
decreases on the other.

Headband

Increases

CO 4 sts.

Rows 1-4: Starting with a knit row, work
four rows in Stockinette Stitch.

Row 5: K1, M1, K to last 2 sts, M1, K1. 2 sts
inc.

Row 6: P across.

Rep Rows 1-6 nine more times. 24 sts.

Body

WE in St st until piece measures 23" ending
with a purl row.

Decreases

Row 1: K1, SSK, K to last 3 sts, K2tog, K1. 2
sts dec.

Rows 2-6: Starting with a purl row, work
five rows in St st.

Rep Rows 1-6 nine more times. 4 sts.

Work two more rows in St st.

Break yarn leaving a 12" tail.

Finishing

Draw tail through remaining live sts.

Weave in end both ends and block to
measurements.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = begin(ning)(s)

CO = Cast On

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit 2 together

M1 = Make 1 Stitch

P = Purl

rep = repeat

RS = right side

SSK = slip, slip, knit these 2 stitches
together

st(s) = stitches
