


SIRDAR



*Ribbed Hat, Hand
Warmers and Scarf*

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INTERMEDIATE

SIZE

Scarf Finished Length

78¾ in, 200cm

Finished Width

9½ in, 24 cm

Hand Warmers Finished Length

8¾ in, 22cm

Hat Finished Circumference

17 in, 43 cm

GAUGE

19 Stitches = about 5 in (10 cm) width

42 Rows = about 4 in (10cm) depth.

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- SIRDAR COUNTRY CLASSIC DK, 50g, (Ref F235) Teal (865)
- Pair of 4mm (UK8 – USA6) Knitting Needles.)
- Scarf x 7 balls
- Hand Warmers x 1 ball
- Hat x 1 ball

NOTES

1. Cast on and off loosely.
2. For the Hat: The LLD (left leaning decrease) and the RLD (right leaning decrease) are worked across 3 stitches and working into the row below of the 1st and 3rd stitches will give you 2 loops on the needle for each stitch. Where stitches have 2 loops then treat them the same as single loop stitches.

SCARF

Using thumb method cast on 45 sts.

Foundation Row. Knit.

**** 1st Row (rs).** * K1, k1b, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd Row. K1, * k1, k1b, rep from

* to last 2 sts, k2.

1st and 2nd rows set fisherman's rib patt. ******

Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until scarf measures 200cm, (78¾in), ending with 2nd row of patt.

Cast off in patt.

TO COMPLETE

Pin out scarf to the measurement given. Cover with damp cloths and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

HAND WARMERS (Knit 2)

Using thumb method cast on 41 sts.

Foundation Row. Knit.

Work as given for Scarf from

**** to **.**

Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until hand warmer measures 22cm, (8¾in), ending with 2nd row of patt.

Cast off knitways.

ABBREVIATIONS

cm - centimetres

cont - continue

DK - double knitting

g - grammes

in - inch(es)

k - knit

k1b - knit into next stitch on row below

LHN - left hand needle

mm - millimetres

patt - pattern

psso - pass slipped stitch over

rep - repeat

rem - remain(ing)

RHN - right hand needle

st(s) - stitch(es)

s1b - insert the RHN into the row below of the next stitch on the needle and slip it knitways

tog - together

LLD - slip next 3 stitches purlways onto the RHN. Work on these 3 stitches as follows:-insert the LHN into the row below of the 1st stitch and slip it back onto the LHN, slip the 2nd stitch purlways back onto the LHN then insert the needle into the row below of the 3rd stitch and slip it back onto the LHN. Now slip 1st stitch on LHN knitways onto RHN, knit the next 2 stitches together and pass the 1st stitch over to complete the left leaning double decrease.

RLD - slip next 3 stitches purlways onto the RHN. Work on these 3 stitches as follows:-insert the LHN into the row below of the 1st stitch and slip it back onto the LHN, slip the 2nd stitch purlways back onto the LHN then insert the needle into the row below of the 3rd stitch and slip it back onto the LHN. K3tog to complete the right leaning decrease.

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TO MAKE UP

Join side seams 11cm, (4¼in) up from cast on edge and 6cm, (2½in) down from cast off edge, leaving a 5cm, (2in) opening for thumb. Cover with a damp cloth and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

HAT

Using thumb method cast on 81 sts.

Foundation Row. Knit.

Work as given for Scarf from ** to **

Working in patt as set (throughout) cont until hat measures 24cm, (9½in), ending with 2nd row of patt.

Shape Crown

1st Row. K1, * LLD, patt 13, RLD, k1, rep from * to end. 65 sts.

2nd Row. K1, * k1, k1b, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2.

3rd Row. * K1, k1b, rep from * to last st, k1.

4th Row. As 2nd row.

5th Row. As 3rd row.

6th Row. As 2nd row.

7th Row. K1, * LLD, patt 9, RLD, k1, rep from * to end. 49 sts.

8th Row. As 2nd row.

9th Row. As 3rd row.

10th Row. As 2nd row.

11th Row. As 3rd row.

12th Row. As 2nd row.

13th Row. K1, * LLD, patt 5, RLD, k1, rep from * to end. 33 sts.

14th Row. As 2nd row.

15th Row. As 3rd row.

16th Row. As 2nd row.

17th Row. As 3rd row.

18th Row. As 2nd row.

19th Row. K1, * LLD, patt 1, RLD, k1, rep from * to end. 17 sts.

20th Row. As 2nd row.

21st Row. K1, * s1b, k1, psso, rep from * to last 2 sts, k2. 10 sts.

Break off yarn, run yarn through rem 10 sts, draw up and fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Join back seam reversing sewing for 6cm, (2½in) turnback. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.



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
