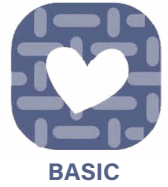




Yarn Wrapped Pumpkins

Yarn Wrapped Pumpkins



MEASUREMENTS

Extra-Large: 6" [15cm] diameter x 7" [18 cm] tall.

Large: 5½" [14 cm] diameter x 4" [10 cm] tall.

Medium (2): 4" [10 cm] diameter x 2½" [6 cm] tall.

Small: 2¾" [7 cm] diameter x 2" [5 cm] tall.

MATERIALS

- **Bernat® Blanket®**
(10.5 oz/300 g; 220 yds/201 m)
- **Extra-Large:**
Contrast A Pumpkin Spice (10630)
1 ball or 30 yds/27.5 m
- **Large:**
Contrast B Purple Plum (10430)
1 ball or 24 yds/22 m
- **Medium:**
Contrast C Burnt Mustard (10874)
1 ball or 11 yds/10 m **or**
Contrast D Tan Pink (10898)
1 ball or 11 yds/10 m

Small:

Contrast E Light Teal (10734)
1 ball or 7 yds/6.5 m

Note: 1 ball can make 7 Extra-Large / 9 Large / 20 Medium / 31 Small Pumpkins.

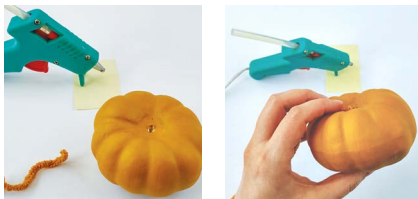
- 5 assorted foam pumpkins.
- Hot glue gun and glue.
- Scissors.
- Optional: Acrylic paint to match yarn.
- Small flat paint brush.

INSTRUCTIONS

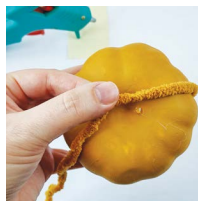
1. Remove stem from foam pumpkin.
2. (Optional) Using paint to match yarn color, paint foam pumpkin and let dry to avoid seeing bright contrast through wrapped yarn.



3. Using hot glue gun, place small dab of glue at top of pumpkin where stem was removed and glue yarn end in place.



4. Wrap yarn down and around side of Pumpkin, securing at base with hot glue.
5. Wrap up opposite side of Pumpkin, securing in place at top of Pumpkin with glue.



6. Continue wrapping yarn around Pumpkin, ensuring yarn strands sit evenly side-by-side and cross over at the bottom, securing with glue as necessary, until entire Pumpkin has been covered.

7. Cut yarn and secure final end at bottom of pumpkin.



8. Reattach stem at top of Pumpkin securing in place with glue, or secure a small branch in place for a more rustic look.
9. Repeat Steps 1 to 8 for remaining Pumpkins.
