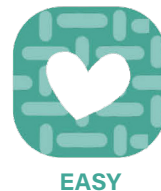




Falling Leaves Mobile

Falling Leaves Mobile



SIZE

Finished Diameter

Approximately 28 inches

MATERIALS

- Cascade Yarns® Cascade 220® — 100% Peruvian Highland Wool, 100 g (3.5 oz) / 220 yds (200 m)
 - 1 skein each: #9404-Ruby, #9463B Gold, #7824 Jack O Lantern
- Cardboard
- Scissors
- Pruners
- Yarn needle
- 2 branches, 28" long

INSTRUCTIONS

Print leaf template onto paper and cut leaves out.

Trace each leaf template onto cardboard three times.

Use scissors to cut out the cardboard leaves.

Optional: Use scissors to cut 1/8" slits every 1/8-1/4" on the perimeter of the leaves. This will help prevent the yarn from slipping.

Wrap yarn around the leaves until cardboard is covered to your liking. You can use a different color for each shape, every shape in every color, or you can even use multiple colors per leaf.

Secure yarn off at the stem of the leaf by knotting, leaving a long tail to hang the leaves. A yarn needle is helpful for this step.

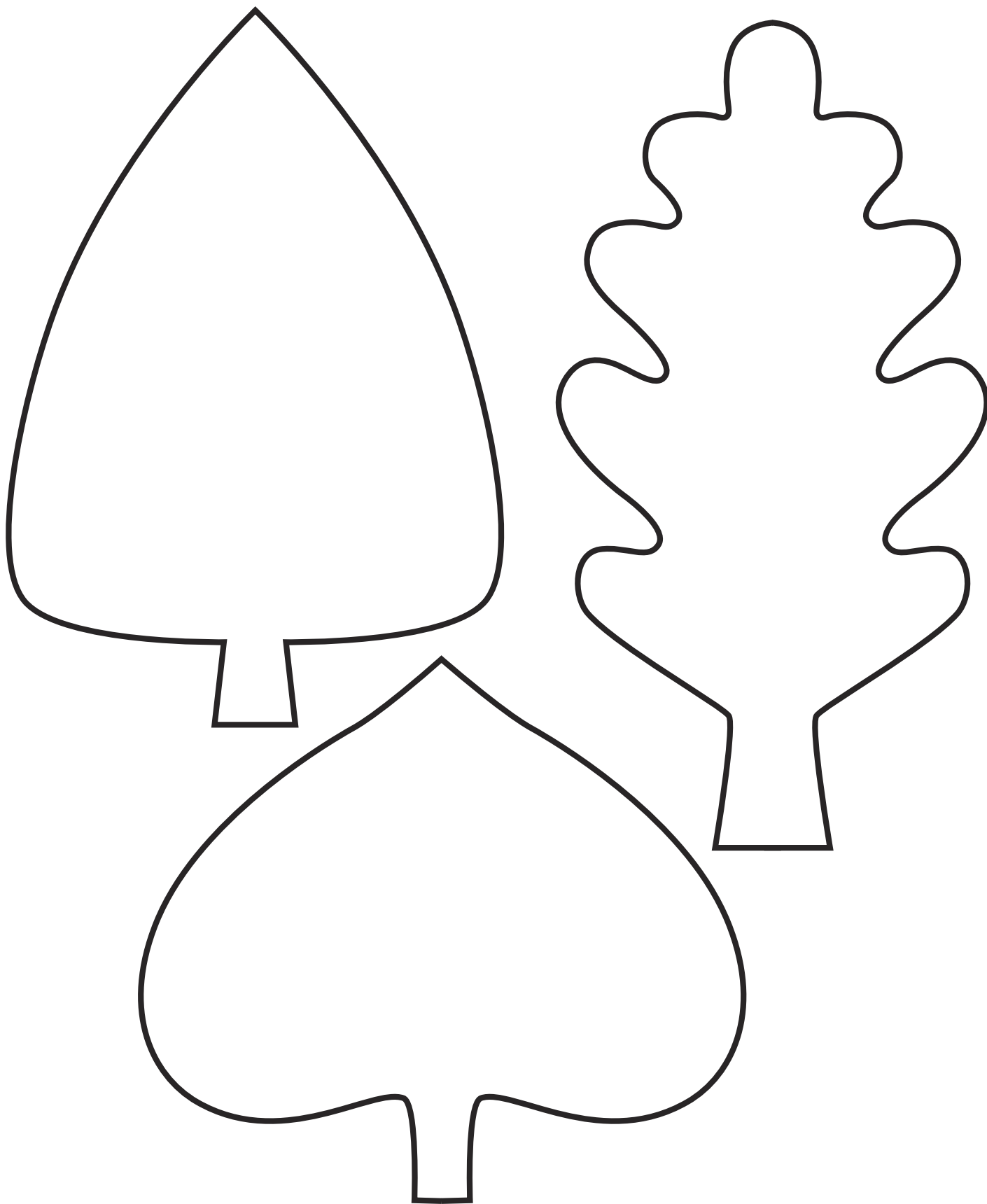
Tie the two branches together with yarn into an X. Wrap in multiple directions for a secure mobile. Tie off, leaving a long tail for hanging.

Tie leaves to branches. With 9 leaves, put 2 leaves on each arm of the mobile and one in the center. Try to counterbalance the leaves by adjusting the placement.

If necessary, pruners can be used to shorten the branches for counterbalance. Double or triple knot to tie off securely.
