Neighborhoodly Placemats

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EASY

SIZE

Finished Measurements

17" wide x 12" tall

GAUGE

7 sts x 14 rows = 4" (10 cm) Blocked,
in (sc, ch 1, sc) stitch

Be sure to check your gauge.

MATERIALS

- Cascade Yarns® Cascade 220®
100% Peruvian Highland Wool;
100 g (3.5 oz), 220 yds (200 m);
 - 1 skein each: #1054 Mallard Blue (A),
#9463B Gold (B), #7824 Jack O Lantern (C)
- I/9 (5.5 mm) crochet hook
- Yarn needle

NOTES

1. Edges will not be straight, the first and last stitches will create a scalloped effect.

PLACEMAT

Row 1: With A, ch 56, (sc, ch 1, sc) in 2nd ch from hook, [sk 1 ch, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next ch] rep across, turn. -28 (sc, ch 1, sc) groups

Row 2: Ch 1, (sc, ch 1, sc) in first sc, [sk ch-1 sp and next sc, (sc, ch 1, sc) in next sc] rep across, leave last ch-1 sp and sc unworked, turn. -28 (sc, ch 1, sc) groups

Rows 3-42: Following Color Sequence, rep Row 2.

Fasten off. Weave in ends. Block to given measurements.

COLOR SEQUENCE

Rows 1-5: A

Rows 6-10: B

Rows 11-15: C

Rows 16-17: A

Rows 18-19: B

Rows 20-21: C

Rows 22-23: A

Rows 24-25: B

Rows 26-27: C

Rows 28-32: A

Rows 33-37: B

Rows 38-42: C

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain stitch

rep = repeat

sc = single crochet

sk = skip

sp = space

st(s) = stitch(es)
